**NEW BUSINESS:**

**RIVERSIDE TOWER CONTRACT**

Nicole Schell came before the board for the above contract with Jacobi, Toombs and Lanz for engineering services regarding perimeter improvements to the Riverside Towers Public Improvement Project. The total amount of the engineering service is not to exceed \$20,000.00 although the consultant reserves the right to request adjustments as a result of scope changes beyond their control.

Carlow made a motion to approve the contract, seconded by Eaglin. All in favor, motion carried (3-0).

**AGREEMENT FOR TRASH RATE STUDY**

Bob Cooke came before the board to present an agreement with Sherman, Barber and Mullikin for a trash rate study. Rumpke is raising their rates so it will become necessary for a rate increase for the city to meet its obligations. Cooke expected the study to cost between \$5,000.00 and \$7,000.00.

Eaglin made a motion to approve the contract, seconded by Carlow. All in favor, motion carried (3-0).

Courtney introduced John Wallace as the new Police Chief for the city.

Wallace stated that it was an honor to be able to serve the city again in this capacity. He said he has a great nucleus around him. He will be meeting with the force at 2:00 pm for orientation. He thanked Major McKay for all his help with the transition.

Brian Martin reported that things are going well in the building inspector's office. The office is getting numerous calls and the updates for building permits is moving along smoothly with an emphasis on cooperation. He said John Schuring has been a big help. The unsafe structure program is proceeding.
