1. **Michael G. Prickett - C. of A. to remove permastone and replace with brick face, new entrance, new entrance door, new cloth awnings and removal of fixed aluminum canopy at 319 E. Main Street. Zoned Central Business District (CBD)**
2. **Pearl Park/Mary E. Munier - C. of A. to change location of the Wagon Factory to the far east side of the park area at 710-712 N. West Street. Zoned General Business (GB)**
3. **Orville B. Dunagan - C. of A. to replace roof as is, add new vinyl siding over wood, build 12' x 12' covered deck w/roof which will be flat w/gingerbread - brackets and railing at 128 West Street. Zoned Open Space (OS)**
