- I. Meeting was called to order at 9:06 AM by Chair, Bob Canida.
- II. Minutes of [date of previous] HRC meeting were read. A motion was made to approve minutes with no additions or corrections. Motion was seconded. All in favor. Motion passed.
- III. Election of officers

Canida moved to nominate Montoya as Chair. Pimlott seconded. All in favor. Motion passed.

Kloepfer moved to nominate Livers as Vice-Chair. Watson seconded. All in favor. Motion passed.

Kloepfer moved to nominate Pimlott as Secretary. Canida seconded. All in favor. Motion passed.

"Gavel" was passed to Montoya.

IV. Canida made a motion to change the position of Secretary to Secretary/Treasurer. Pimlott seconded. Motion was discussed. All in favor. Motion passed.

- V. Carri Dirksen from KDH talked about the Healthy Communities Initiative. She discussed the Kindness Initiative as well as the book <u>A Case for Kindness</u> by Lisa Barrickman. The book will be used for the Kindness Challenge, which will run for forty days from April 2nd through May 12th. Canida made a motion to use <u>A Case for Kindness</u> as the One Community/One Book for 2018. Pimlott seconded. All in favor. Motion passed. The previously scheduled book, <u>Just Mercy</u>, will be postponed until 2019 with a date to be determined. Judge Ted Todd has agreed to chair a panel discussion for <u>Just Mercy</u> at that time.
- VI. Montoya spoke about Compassionate Cities. The City Council has on its agenda for February 20th to vote on a resolution affirming the Charter for Compassion. Montoya read the Charter to Commission members.
- VII. The Commission discussed approaching the City of Madison concerning funding copies of future One Book/One Community choices for the library. Montoya offered to speak with the Mayor's office.

VIII. The Commission discussed options for future meeting dates and times.
